Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are all aware, the government has advised That the Moorabool Shire is entering a 7day lockdown from 11.59pm tonight (Friday 1st October 2021). As a result, we will be returning to a remote learning model for the week starting Monday 4th October 2021.

All students from Grade Foundation to 6 will have a 1-hour online lesson with their teacher on Monday. This will be the only learning requirement for Monday. Teachers will load the timetable for the rest of the week later on Monday. We will reimplement our welfare Wednesday for this week.

Advice regarding our return to school from Monday 11th October 2021 will be announced later in the week.

Limited onsite supervision will be provided at Pentland Primary School for the duration of the remote learning period. Onsite supervision of students will only be available for parents who fall in the 'essential worker' category, as per the last lock down period

Parents requesting their children to attend site must forward the onsite attendance form and valid current worker permits for all guardians to the school email account by 4pm Sunday 3rd October.

Please see below the description of each of the 3 reasons why a child can be allowed to be onsite during this period.

1. All guardians are authorised workers and are unable to work from home.
2. My child identifies as vulnerable, and I am requesting they attend on-site as they fall under this category.
3. My child/ren has a disability* and I am requesting they attend on-site based on parent choice.

Children who attend the onsite supervision program will be required to wear uniform and bring lunch, snacks and a drink bottle. Entry to the school will be via the main gate in Halletts Way, students will be meeting on the basketball court and once again, parents are not permitted to be onsite during this period.

Once again, thanks for your support during these times and remember to reach out to us if you are struggling. We will endeavour to support you in whatever ways we can.
